LESSON 1: Godhead Three In One

ANCHOR STATEMENT: The Trinity refers to the Godhead Three in One: That is, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

MAIN PASSAGE: Isaiah 64:8

Yet you, Lord, are our Father. We are the clay; you are the potter; we are all the work of your hand.

Colossians 2:6-10

6 So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, 7 rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

8 See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the elemental spiritual forces [a] of this world rather than on Christ.

9 For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form, 10 and in Christ you have been brought to fullness. He is the head over every power and authority.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20

Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; 20 you were bought at a price. Therefore, honor God with your bodies.

WHAT WE WANT STUDENTS TO KNOW: What the Trinity is and what the Trinity is not so that they can have a better understanding of why Christians proclaim a Trinitarian God.

WHAT WE WANT STUDENTS TO DO WITH WHAT THEY'VE LEARNED: Grow in their ability to understand and discuss the Trinity and be better equipped to answer questions about it.
